To be eligible for entry, applicants must:

- ▶ Be 30 years or younger as at 31 December 2018.
- ▶ Be employed at a feedlot that is a current financial Member of the Australian Lot Feeders' Association.
- ▶ Have completed all sections of the entry form and provided all necessary documents.
- ▶ Be available to travel to Sydney, NSW on 22 – 23 August 2018 for the Second Round of Judging; a face-to-face interview with the judging panel.
- ▶ Be available to attend BeefEx conference in Brisbane, Qld on 8 – 10 October for Final Round of Judging and the announcement of the Overall Winner.
- ▶ Agrees to be part of the promotion of the Award.
