

PRIZES

FINALISTS

GRAND FINALISTS

- Three Grand Finalists are invited to ALFA BeefEx Conference for the presentation of the Overall Winner. Included in the prize are flights, accommodation and registration to the event.
- Provided training in professional presentations and creating engaging content around story-telling.

OVERALL WINNER

- Your name is added to the Award perpetual trophy and you receive a keepsake trophy.
- Funding towards undertaking a professional development course or overseas study trip, to the value of \$5,000.
- An industry scholarship to attend the next Australian Rural Leadership Foundation's TRAIL: for emerging leaders program valued at \$10,450.

ENTRY CRITERIA

To be eligible for entry, applicants must:

- ▶ Be 30 years or younger as at 31 December 2022.
- ▶ Be employed at a feedlot that is a current financial Member of the Australian Lot Feeders' Association.
- ▶ Have completed all sections of the entry form and provided all necessary documents.
- ▶ Be available to travel to Sydney, NSW, on 24 August 2022 for Second Round Judging; a face-to-face interview with the judging panel.
- ▶ Be available to attend the ALFA BeefEx Conference on 18 - 20 October 2022 for the announcement of the Overall Winner.
- ▶ Agree to be a part of the promotion of the Award.
